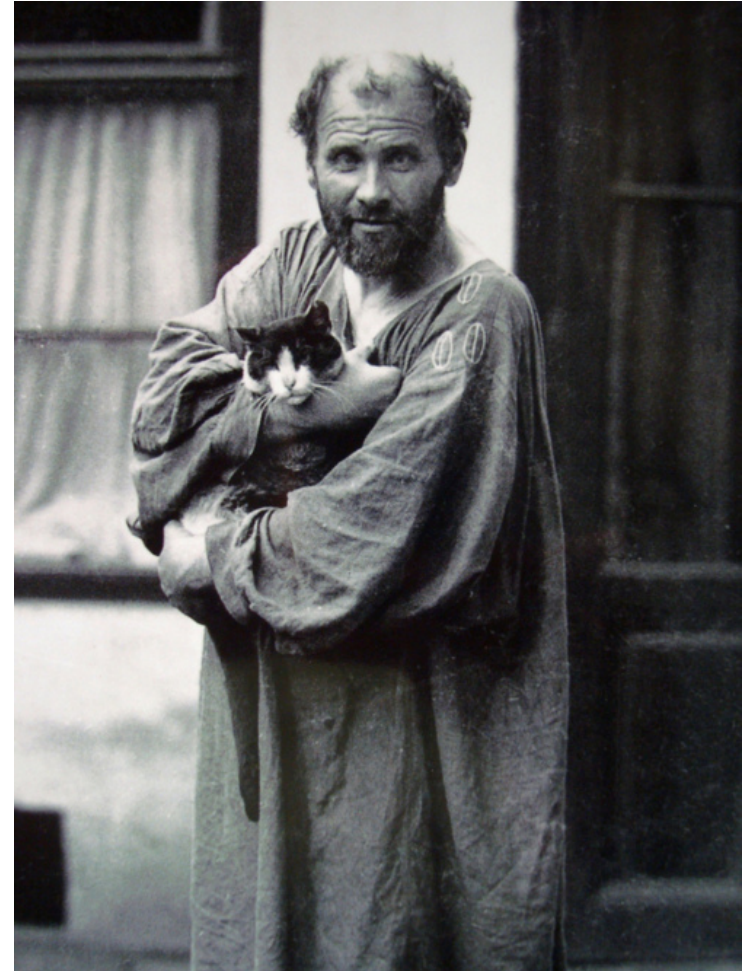

Gustav Klimt

- Gustav Klimt was an Austrian artist
- He lived from 1862-1918
- Gustav Klimt's home city was the fascinating turn-of-the-century Vienna of the *belle époque*.



Gustav Klimt

- He was an academic and founded a group called the Vienna Secession
- His work is highly decorative
- He was a leader in the movement called Art Nouveau



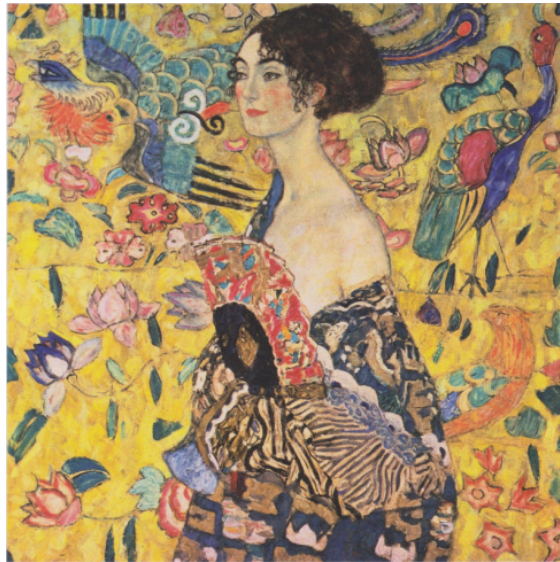
Gustav Klimt



- Klimt liked looking at Byzantine Icons
- In nearly every painting he used gold
- Interestingly, his father was a goldsmith

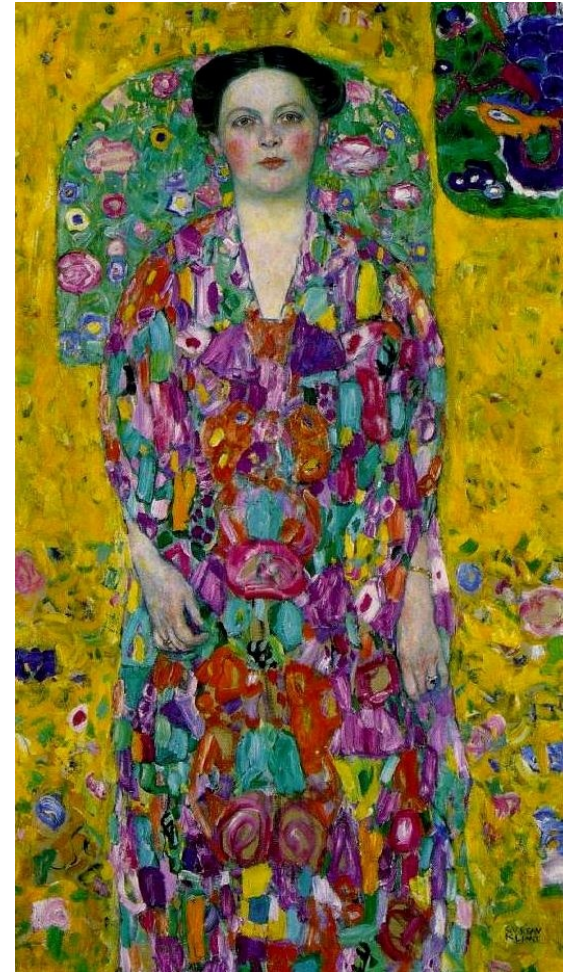
Gustav Klimt

- Klimt liked to paint portraits, especially of women
- Sometimes these were colourful

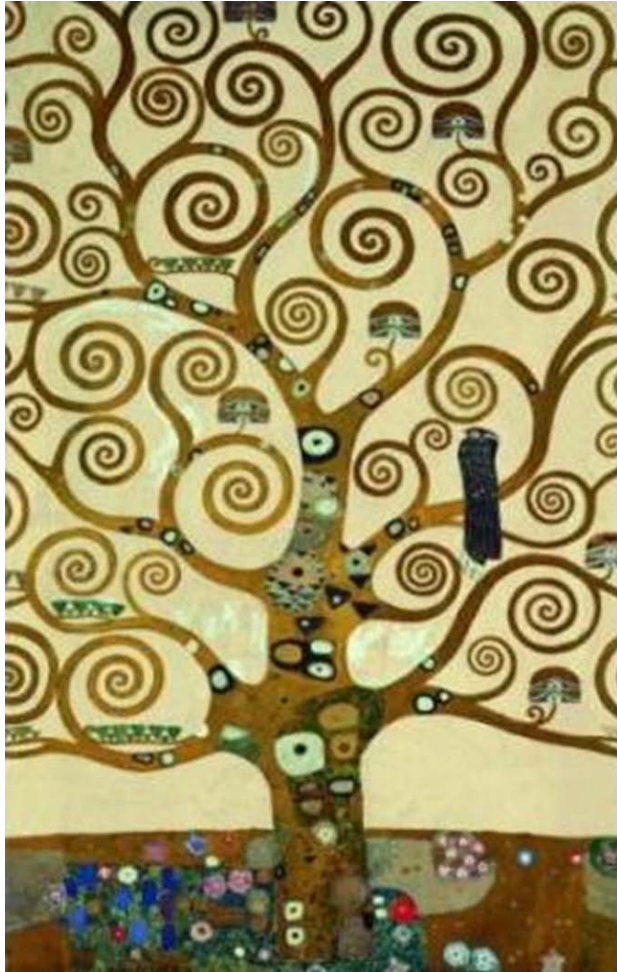
- Often they were covered in golden patterns
