 - Sudety
 - Karpaty.

Some facts about polish mountains

- Tallest mountain - Rysy – 2499 above sea level
- Biggest lake – Morskie oko, 60 ha
- Longest slope – Kasprowy Wierch, 6 km
- Longest valley – Chochołowska Valley, 10 km
- Longest tourist trail – Sudecki trail, 356 km
- Biggest town – Zakopane, 84 km²
- Strongest wind – 345 km/h



Highlander Dialect

- is the inaccurate, current term for dialect of residents of Polish Carpathian mountains, but it's often identified only with the Podhale dialect. Linguists don't think there exists only one highlander dialect, but several different dialects:
 - Podhale dialect
 - Orava dialect
 - Sądecki dialect
 - Spiski dialect
 - Żywiecki dialect
 - Silesian highlander dialect
 - Łącki highlanders dialect
 - Zagórzański dialect
 - Cieszyński dialect
 - Jablunkov dialect

National Costumes Of Poland

- very big region. They are not worn in a daily life but at folk festivals, folk weddings, religious holidays, harvest festivals and other special occasions. The costumes reflect region origin and sometimes social or marital status.
- Poland's inhabitants live in the following historic regions of the country: Greater Poland, Lesser Poland, Mazovia, Pomerania, Warmia, Masuria, Podlasie, Kujawy and Silesia.

Polish Cuisine

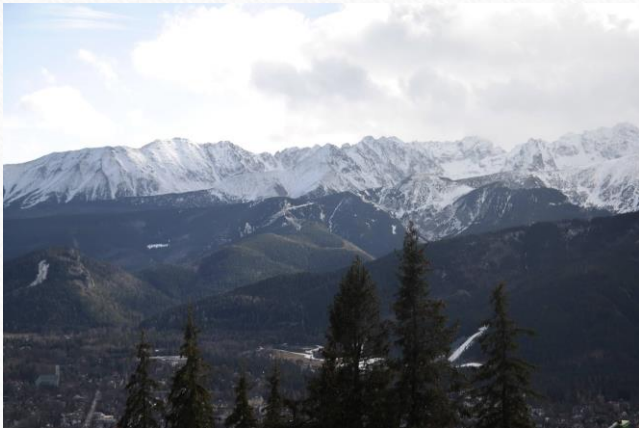
- has evolved over the centuries to become very eclectic due to Poland's history. Polish cuisine shares a lot with other Polish neighbour cuisines, especially Czech, Slovak, German, Belarusian, Ukrainian and the Russian one.
- The Polish national dishes are bigos, dumplings, sausages, pork chop, gołąbki (type of cabbage roll), zrazy (type of roulade), roast, sour cucumber soup, mushroom soup, tomato soup, rosół (variety of meat broth), żurek (sour rye soup), flaki (variety of tripe soup) and borsch.
