A little about sport in Poland

Football

Unsurprisingly, football is the most popular sport in Poland. The Polish National Football Team was the winner of the 1972 Olympic Football Tournament, and a runner-up in 1976 and 1992. Poland has made seven FIFA World Cup appearances in 1938, 1974, 1978, 1982, 1986, 2002 and 2006, and have succeeded considerably, finishing third at both the 1974 World Cup in Germany and the 1982 World Cup in Spain.

Basketball

Basketball is one of Poland's most popular sports. In the 1960s, the national team belonged to the world elite; it won silver at the 1963 European Basketball Championship and bronze at the 1965 and 1967 event. In the 1967 FIBA World Championship, Poland was among the world's five elite basketball teams. At the 1964 and 1968 Summer Olympics, the Orły ("Eagles," as the team is often nicknamed) finished 6th.
